

POST HOLE AUGER



SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. A licence for high risk work to operate earthmoving plant; however, operators should hold a verification of competency or statement of attainment issued by a RTO and be authorised to do so before they are to operate plant (Note: VOC is not required to operate mini-skid steer plant).
- 2. Always follow manufacturer's safe operating instructions when operating plant or machinery.
